Travel / Directions

There are two options for getting from Paris Charles de Gaulles Airport to Reims round trip:

Option 1 : By train, using the high speed TGV.

You can either book the tickets before your arrival via your travel agency or buy them at the station when you arrive.

a - Directly from the **TGV station** in the terminal 2 of the airport. See the attached Time table.

b - Take a taxi to **PARIS EST station** (1 to 1.5 hour depending on traffic), then catch a train. See the timetable attached.

When you arrive at **Reims** or **Champagne Ardenne** station the hotels are a 10 minute taxi ride.

Option 2 : By car, using a rental car.

Follow the indications as per the mappy file attached (1.5 to 2 hours drive depending on traffic).

Avoid taking a taxi from the airport to Reims because the cost will be very expensive.
